Badge Requirements:

1. Get to Know the Tools of the Trade
2. Make Jewelry With Metal
3. Turn Everyday Objects Into Jewelry
4. Create Jewelry Inspired by Another Culture
5. Make a Sparkling Gift



What to Expect:

- The troop should discuss step #1 prior to coming to Total Arts to be somewhat familiar with the tools they may be using in class
- At Total Arts, there are two options for this badge:
 - Option 1: A single 1.5 hour session to cover steps 2 & 3. There is usually also time to make a gift for someone else to complete step #5.
 - Option 2: A single 2 hour session to cover steps #2, 3, 4, & 5



Fees:

- Option 1: Single 1.5-hour session to complete steps #2, 3, & 5:
 - \$150 includes up to 10 Girl Scouts
 - Each additional Girl Scout is \$15
- Option 2: Single 2-hour session to complete steps #2, 3, 4, & 5:
 - \$200 includes up to 10 Girl Scouts
 - Each additional Girl Scout is \$20
- A \$50 deposit is required to secure your date
- The remaining balance is due at the event



NOTE: The final expected number of Girl Scouts will be requested 2 days prior to your event. Your balance due will be based on this final number even if not everyone attends the class. We cannot guarantee that we can accommodate participants over this final head count.
