Badge Requirements:

- 1. Discover Art & Design Around You
- 2. Make Art About a Subject
- 3. Experiment With the Elements
- 4. Explore Composition
- 5. Design an Art Displau





What to Expect:

- The troop should become familiar with the basic idea of Art & Design prior to coming to Total Arts for the session
- At Total Arts, Juniors will complete the following in a 2 hour class designed to fulfill requirements for the Art & Design badge;
 - Explore materials such as pens, pencils. and charcoal
 - Draw a simple sphere and rectangle using shading techniques
 - Discuss and practice simple perspective techniques
 - Use their new skills to draw from observation (still life items)
 - o Mount finished projects for display, as time allows

Fees: (Level 3)

- \$325 for the 2 hour class, includes up to 10 Girl Scouts
 - Each additional Girl Scout is \$20
- · A \$100 deposit is required to secure your date
- · The remaining balance is due at the event

NOTES: The final expected number of Girl Scouts will be requested 2 days prior to your event.

- Your balance due will be based on this final number even if not everyone attends the class.
- We cannot guarantee that we can accommodate participants over this final head count.

Two Girl Scout approved adults must remain onsite during the event, per GS guidelines.

- Additional adults may be required by Total Arts for large groups (20+), to assist with the activities.
